- **Financial support with utility bills**, keeping heat on for families during the cold months of winter.
- **Holiday toy programs**, helping all children experience the joys of the holiday season.
- **Holiday meals and gift baskets** to combat the hunger and isolation that winter and poverty can bring.
- **Out of the Cold programs**, providing hot meals and/or beds to the homeless and hungry.
